## Monday, May 11 Board Meeting

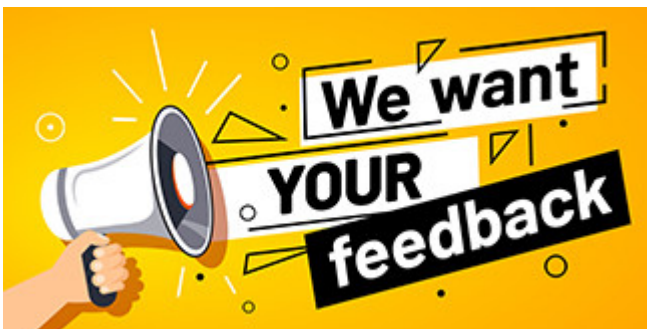
