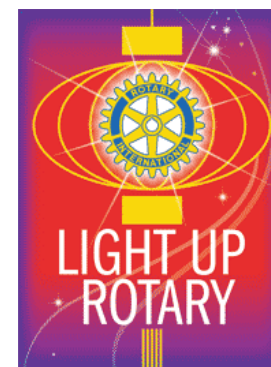

Today's Program

Distracted Driving

Alex Sorohan

Alex Sorohan will speak on "Distracted Driving," a subject heavily emphasized by the District Governor this year. Alex is a 20-year-old who currently lives in Rutledge, GA and is entering her junior year at Berry College, where she is studying Biochemistry and Pre-Veterinary medicine. After losing her older brother in a texting-while-driving car accident when she was 15, Alex has been working to educate teens and adults about the dangers of texting while driving. She has spoken to high schools and colleges around the State of Georgia and at highway safety conferences around the country. While in high school, Alex worked with a grant from the Governor's Office of Highway Safety to organize a group of high school students to travel through high schools and educate students about the consequences that come when people choose to text while they drive. In 2010 Alex was heavily involved in getting the texting-while-driving law passed for the State of Georgia. Currently Alex is active in promoting new legislation that would enforce a complete ban on handheld devices for drivers of all ages, similar to laws in other states.
